Patricia "Trisha" Ann Hewitt, 53, of Solvay, passed away peacefully at Upstate Hospital, November 12th and graduated from Solvay High School in 1985. She was predeceased by her father, Patrick George in 2009.

She is survived by her children, Cory, Carly, Claire, and Connor Hewitt; former husband, John Hewitt; mother, Dee George; brother, Brian George; sister, Michelle (Duane) Dedrick, and several nieces and nephews.

Trisha was feisty and outspoken but would do anything for anyone, and she always lit up the room with her smile and sense of humor -- even while struggling with her addiction. Trisha isn't just another statistic or just "another one gone too soon"; she had a great heart with a bright future. She had a gift that the world sadly lost, and that can never be replaced. She never hid her addiction and would want her story to be told to help even just one addict to push even harder for another day of sobriety. She would encourage an active user to choose recovery. She would want to shine a light on this horrible epidemic of addiction. This amazing woman should be remembered for these reasons and not her mistakes. She will be missed, is still loved, is at peace, and is now free.
