My heart aches for the pain you must be feeling at the loss of your mother.

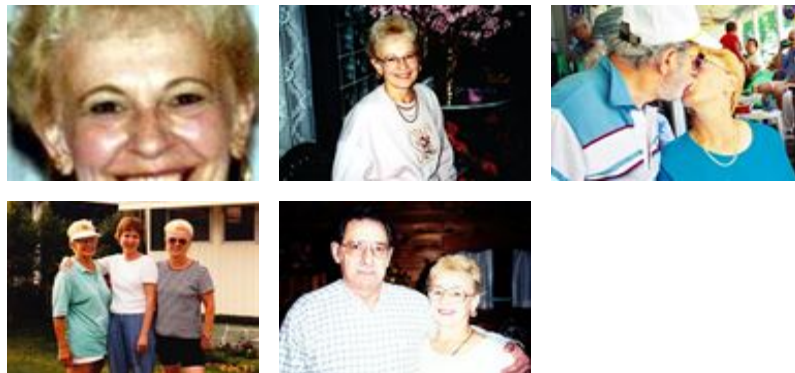
