August 29, 1921 - January 21, 2022

Albert J. Francescotti, 100, of Solvay, passed away Friday January 21st at Iroquois Nursing Home. He was born in Solvay to the late James and Rose (Fabio) Francescotti in 1921 and was a US Army Veteran of World War II. A longtime carpenter, he retired as such from the NYS Fairgrounds. Al was an outdoorsman and hunter. He was also an avid golfer and bowler. He was a member of the Tyrol Club of Solvay, Solvay-Geddes Veterans, Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post 2893, Solvay Tigers AC and a communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church. He was predeceased by his wife, Lucy (Geiss) in 2016 and his sister, Emma and brother, Robert.
