Andrew "Andy" M. Herne, 86, passed away on Friday, December 22, 2017, at home surrounded by family.

Andy was born on September 1, 1931 in Akwesasne, NY, son of Norbert and Frances Herne. He attended the Thomas Indian School on the Cattaraugus Reservation in Irving, NY. He served in the United States Army 1st Bn. 16th INF. REGT. 1st Division from 1948 to 1954. After his service, he worked in various capacities on the St. Lawrence Seaway, at the Snell Lock in Massena, NY until his retirement. In his retirement, he held various community service positions for the Malone Senior Center and Meals on Wheels, and was a part-time rural route postman for the US Postal Service and lived his life in service to others and made it a point to do a good turn daily for others. Andy was a member of the American Legion, 4th Degree Knight in the Knights of Columbus, and served as a volunteer in Boy Scouts of America, Troop 20 in Brushton, NY. Andy was also a parishioner and lector at St. Mary's Parish in Brushton, NY.

Andrew Herne is predeceased by his parents and wife Carol (Sousie). He is survived by his sister Lilly Benedict of Akwesasne, NY and a half-sister Marlene Nolan of Syracuse, NY; children Timothy (Marianne G.) Herne of Jordan, NY, Andrea (Richard) Kloster of Auburn, NY, and Tyler (Virginia Blinston) Herne of Jordan, NY, Andrew and Harvey of Hogansburg, NY; eight grandchildren, Kayla, Justin, Onea, Tehya, Taylor, Donovan, Carson, and Katrina.
