



ANGELA (ARTINI) MATTICIO

November 28, 1939 - March 1, 2024

Angela E. (Artini) Matticio, 84, of Solvay, NY, passed away on Friday, March 1, 2024 at Crouse Hospital surrounded by her loving family.

Angela was born November 28, 1939 in Syracuse, NY to the late Vigilio and Annunziata (Rivani) Artini after they immigrated to America from Zuclo, Italy in 1937.

Angela graduated from Solvay High School, in 1958. She then married Michael J. Matticio of Syracuse, NY in 1961 and together they had 3 children, Mark, Christine and David.

Angela worked as an Executive Secretary at Connecticut Mutual Life Insurance Company before becoming a full-time homemaker. She considered her most important job title mother and grandmother and devoted her life to caring for and raising her family.

Angela was a lifelong communicant of St. Cecilia Church and a member of the Tyrol Club of Solvay.

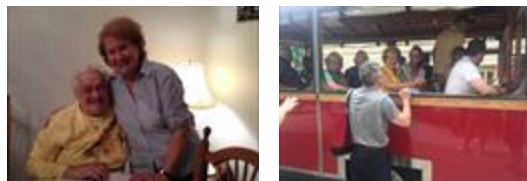
