Angelo Greco, 70, of Solvay, passed away Saturday May 6th at the Syracuse VA Medical Center. He was born in Syracuse to the late Peter and Carmella (Firenza) Greco in 1947. Angelo was a US Navy Veteran serving during the Vietnam War. He was a Registered Nurse in the emergency department of St. Joseph's Hospital for over 22 years before retiring. He was a longtime volunteer and member of WAVES and the Solvay Fire Department.
