



## ANTHONY "BUTCH" GLINSKI

April 30, 1946 - January 19, 2019

Anthony J. "Butch" Glinski, 72, of Solvay, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday. After graduating from Solvay High School in 1964, he served in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Columbus during the Vietnam War. Initially a house painter by trade, he then went to work for the Solvay Police Department for over two decades before retiring as a sergeant. In his free time, he enjoyed hunting, fishing, golfing, baking, casino trips, completing intricate paint-by-numbers, and rooting for the Yankees, but was found most often holding court at the head of his dining room table, sharing coffee and stories with the many visitors who would stop at all hours of the day and night. He was a proud member of the CNY Fraternal Order of Police, Geddes Vets, Solvay Hilltop Club and Solvay Bank Golf League, and coached all three of his sons in Solvay Tigers Little League. He was predeceased by his parents Alpha and Anna (Pucello) Stanley of Solvay.

Tony is survived by his wife of over 49 years, Neva Jeanne (Kermes) Glinski; Sons, Anthony Jr. and David (Elise), of Lakeland, and Michael, of Solvay; Granddaughters, Jillian and Kendall, of Lakeland; Sisters, Rae (Lee) Hogsten, of Kentucky and Bea Stanley, of South Carolina, Brothers-in-law, John C.
