Athena Cambs, of Camillus, New York, was born on January 14, 1930 at St. John's Hospital, to the late Pantelis and Sotoria (Hadjoipoulos) Delinickos. She was raised in Astoria, Queens with her sisters, Bessie, Patricia and Olivia. Athena passed on December 7, 2019, just shy of her 90th birthday.

After graduating from William Cullen Bryant High School in 1948, she attended secretarial school, and became a typist and clerical supervisor for Marsh McLennan, ASCE, and Dowaliby Inc. After raising her children, Athena became a trainer for EBS Data Processing, Inc. in Amityville, NY.

She married Pericles Cambs on September 21, 1952. Mom and dad were both, "sincere and true, in heart and mind, with beautiful memories left behind," until his death on January 7, 1990.

Perry and Tina raised their children, Olivia Cambs, Peter Cambs, and Penelope Cambs in the Bronx and West Islip NY, with a short stay in Florissant, Missouri. She also enjoyed trips to Barbados and St. Lucia, where dad traveled for his work with Dakota Industries.
