Beth (White) Petrella, 92, of Solvay, passed away Wednesday, April 1st at Upstate University Hospital. She was born in Cincinnatus to the late Leon and Elizabeth (Fosgate) White in 1927. Beth worked for the Solvay School District and St. Cecilia Church. She was a member of the Solvay PTO, Solvay High Booster Club, a longtime communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church and member of its Altar and Rosary Society. 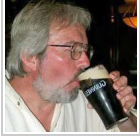
