Carol Lee (Snyder) Fall, 78, of Solvay, passed away Friday, May 15th. She was born and raised in Solvay, graduated from Solvay High School. In 1955, she won the Herald Journal-Herald American Spelling Bee Championship and went on to finish 10th in the Scripps National Spelling Bee.
