



CHARLOTTE (BIANCO) TAROLLI

November 16, 1923 - August 18, 2020

Charlotte (Bianco) Tarolli, 96, of Solvay, passed away Tuesday August 18th St. Camillus. She was born in Solvay to the late Joseph and Mary (Cartoli) Bianco in 1923. Charlotte was the Librarian at St. Cecilia's School when it opened in 1960 until she retired in 1973. She was a lifetime communicant of St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church, past president and member of its Altar and Rosary Society, their choir and St. Joseph's Guild. She was also a member of the Tyrol Club of Solvay Ladies Auxiliary.

Charlotte was predeceased by her husband Peter in 1984 and brother, Eugene Bianco.

She is survived by her daughters; Maria, of Solvay and Barbara, of Walworth and many cousins, nieces and nephews.

Family and friends are invited to attend a Mass of Christian Burial to be celebrated 9:30 am Saturday at St. Marianne Cope Parish-St. Cecilia Church, 1001 Woods Rd. The Rite of Committal and burial will follow in Assumption Cemetery, Syracuse. Facial coverings are required and NYS guidelines on distancing will be observed.
