



DANNIE DANTUONO

December 9, 1925 - January 7, 2024

Dannie David Dantuono, born December 9, 1925, in Lyons, New York to Anna Ricardi and Anthony Dantuono, died of a brief illness on January 7, 2024, at the Francis House. Dannie and Angela went on to marry on November 22, 1947.

From Remington Rand, Dannie went on to his next job at Easy Washer where he was a punch press operator. After that, he transitioned to his next job at Sears & Roebuck repairing televisions. General Electric was Dannie's

last job, where he worked as an electrical designer until his retirement in 1985.

Dannie was an avid fisherman, golfer, bowler, hunter, and artist, but above all else, Dannie was a devoted family man. His children cherish countless memories with him teaching them how to play baseball, football, hockey, golf and much more.

After the loss of his beloved wife, he found companionship with Jeanette Spindler. They enjoyed dancing, traveling, and going to dinner.

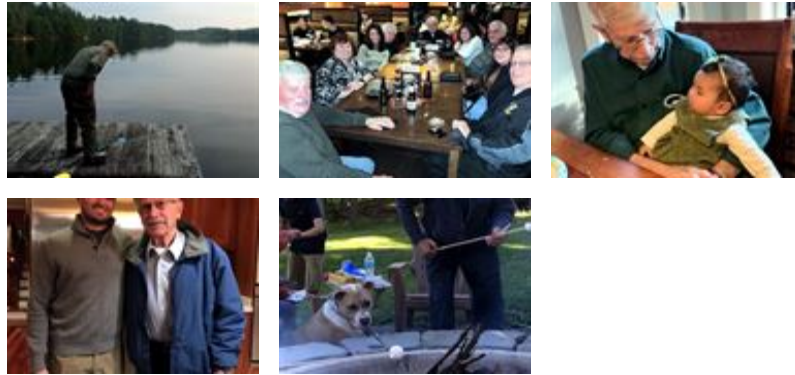
