David M. Musengo, age 70, of Camillus, died after a short but courageous battle with cancer on November 17, 2016.

David is survived by his wife of 44 years, Wendy (Parmenter) Musengo, of Camillus; his Daughters, Jennifer (Robert) Picciott, of Camillus; and Jenelle (Joseph) Burgess, of North Hampton, PA.
