Isidora “Dora” (Miguel) Capella, 83 of Solvay, passed away peacefully Sunday at Upstate University Hospital. Dora was born in Solvay to the late Bruno and Josefa (Gajate) Miguel in 1935. She was a Library Administrator at Solvay Public Library for 36 years before retiring in 2002. She was a parishioner of The Parish of St. Charles-St. Ann’s and former parishioner of St. Cecilia Church. Dora was a member of the Solvay Tyrol Club Auxiliary and its past Vice President for many years. She was also a past member of the Altar and Rosary Society and Geddes Senior Citizens.
