Doris (Fuess) Williams, 98, passed away on Sunday, October 21, 2018 in Liverpool NY. Doris was born on March 12, 1920 in Waterville, NY to Harry M. and Viola P. Fuess where she grew up on a dairy farm. She graduated from Waterville High School, and earned her Bachelor of Arts and Masters of Library Science from Syracuse University. Doris taught English at Van Hornesville High School and was the Librarian at Smith Road Elementary School in North Syracuse until she retired. Doris married John "Jack" F. Williams, her husband of 68 years, on November 25, 1943. They lived in Watertown NY and moved to North Syracuse in 1959, where they lived for the remainder of their lives.
