



## EDWARD M. WEBSTER

April 10, 1943 - March 5, 2024

Edward M. Webster, 80, passed away peacefully at home on March 5, 2024. Ed was predeceased by his wife, Mary Lou (Hunt), his parents, Norman, and Mary Elizabeth (Waters) Webster, his brother Richard Webster, and stepson Daniel Phillips.

He was a 1961 graduate of Solvay High School and a lifelong resident of Solvay until moving to Maple Downs in Fayetteville 1 year ago. Ed was a Vietnam Veteran, serving from 1964-1966. Upon the completion of his military service, he returned home and worked at Corrente's Service Station. He went on to work for the Village of Solvay as the Highway Superintendent and retired from the Onondaga County 911 Center as a Supervisor.

Ed joined the Solvay Fire Department in 1962 and worked his way up the ranks to Chief, serving twice in that position. He was an avid racing fan and worked on Ryan Phelps' pit crew upon his retirement.

He is survived by his daughters, Lynne (Paul) Iamondo, of Warners and Norma (Kevin) Thompson, of Auburn; stepsons, Richard (Michelle) Phillips, of Auburn and Doug (Cindy) Phillips, of Solvay; brothers, Doug Webster, of Solvay and Mark (Valerie) Webster, of Altmar; sisters, Pat (Jim) Flaherty, of Greensboro, NC and Cindy (Doug) Webster, of Solvay; daughter-in-law, Sandi Phillips, 10 grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, several nieces, nephews and cousins.

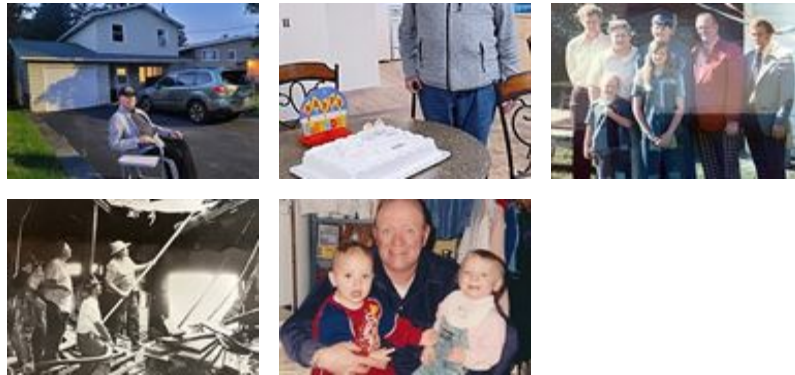
