Elda (Artini) Carducci, 89, of Camillus, passed away peacefully Friday at St. Camillus Health and Rehabilitation Center. Elda was born in Syracuse to the late Severino and Eugenia (Bonenti) Artini in 1929. She worked in the accounting office at Cox Radio/WSYR in Syracuse. 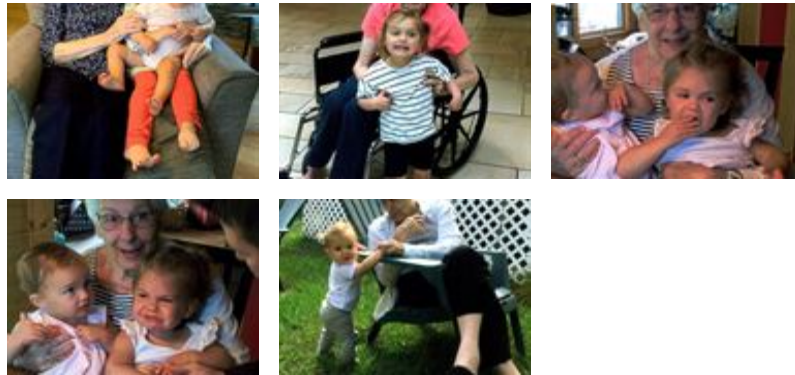
