Eleanor (Tarolli) Cefaratti, 104, of Ponte Vedra, FL, formerly of Solvay, passed away February 10, 2025 at home in Florida with her family by her side. She was born in Syracuse to the late John and Josephine (Lembo) Tarolli in 1920. She graduated from Syracuse University with her Bachelors and later Masters Degree in Education in 1941. She was a teacher at Solvay High School for 35 years, teaching both English and Latin, retiring in 1976. She was a former member of First Christian Assembly Church in Syracuse from 1960-1991, N. Syracuse Baptist Church in N. Syracuse from 1991-2016 and Collins Rd. Baptist Church in Jacksonville, FL from 2016 – present.

She was predeceased by her husband John in 2015. She was also predeceased by her brothers, Edward, John and Richard Tarolli.

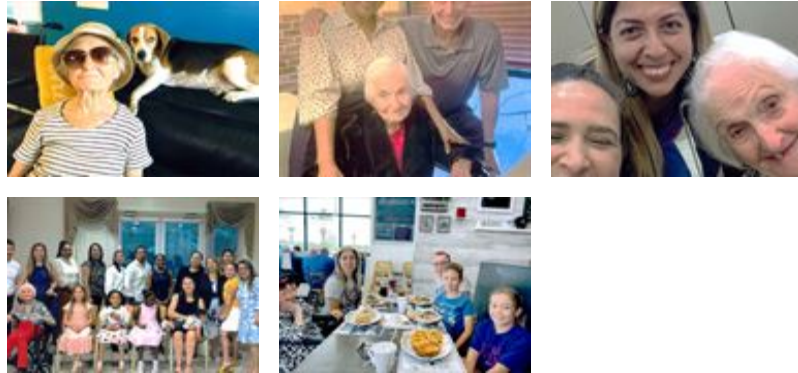
