Elsa (Salvaterra) Barba, 91, of Solvay, passed away peacefully at Upstate University Hospital on April 5, 2019, with her family by her side. Elsa was born on December 28, 1927 in Tione, Italy to the late Emilio and Josephine (Failoni) Salvaterra. After immigrating to the United States in 1930, she was a lifelong resident of Solvay where she graduated from Solvay High School. She worked at New York Telephone Company and continued her career at Solvay Bank where she retired after 35 years of service.

Elsa was a member of the Solvay Tigers Auxiliary and the Solvay Tyrol Club Auxiliary, along with being a member of the Solvay Senior Citizens where she arranged trips for many years. She was honored as Solvay's Citizen of the Year for her work as a member of the Solvay Senior Citizens. Elsa was predeceased by her husband of 67 years, Tony, and her brother Dario (Inga) Salvaterra. 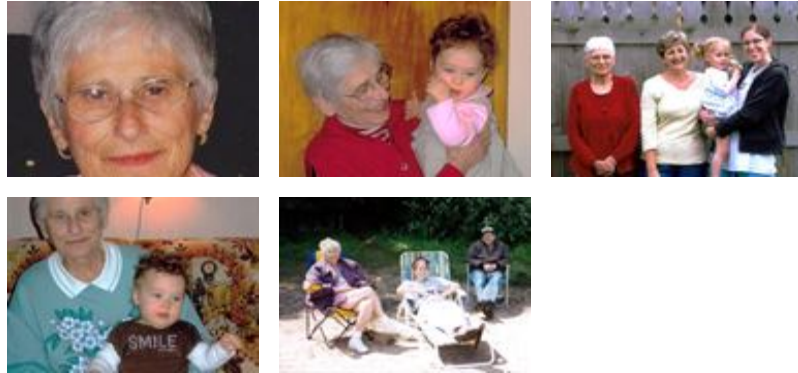
