Enes (Artini) Foresti, 91, of Solvay, passed away peacefully Thursday August 1st with her loving husband and sister by her side. She was born in Syracuse to the late Antonio and Catherine “Catina” (Chemotti) Artini in 1933. She worked as a clerk at Niagara Mohawk for 13 years and Allied Chemical for 11 years before retiring.
