Enia "Annie" (Nicolini) Panelati, 95, formerly of Fairmount, passed away Sunday March 24th at St. Camillus Health and Rehabilitation Center. She was born in Solvay to the late Jacob and Susan (Colotti) Nicolini in 1923 and was a graduate of Solvay High School. She worked all her life as a seamstress, most notably at Sauda's and Patrick's. She loved to dance and was the first member of Fritz's Polka Band. Annie was a member of the Solvay Tyrol Club Auxiliary and the Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post Auxiliary. She was predeceased by her husband, Nathan "Nate" in 1995, her brothers, Adolpho and Renard and infant sister, Viola.

Annie is survived by her daughter; Christine (Arne) Sandness, sister-in-law; Delores Nicolini and several nieces, nephews and cousins.
