



## ENITO L. AURELI

March 11, 1919 - November 10, 2018

Enito L. Aureli, 99, of Fairmount, passed away Saturday November 10th at home. He was born in Solvay to the late Florindo and Clarice (Sciarra) Aureli in 1919. He was a US Army Veteran serving during World War II and was a recipient of both the Bronze Star and Purple Heart.
