October 11, 1923 - January 25, 2018

Esther Naomi (Tosetto) Palma, of Syracuse, passed peacefully into her eternal reward on January 25, 2018 at the age of 94. Born on October 11, 1923 in Niagara Falls, NY, she was the youngest daughter of Maximillian and Mary Tosetto. She married Rev. Alfred Palma on August 26, 1944. They served together in God's service in Niagara Falls, NY, Washington, PA, and 25 years at First Christian Assembly in Syracuse, NY. Their ministry travels also took them to mission fields in Italy, India, Australia and South America. Esther directed the choir, led the church's seniors ministry, and volunteered at St. Camillus for many years. She cherished her grandchildren and great grandchildren, as well as the time she spent tending to her gardens. Her beloved husband died on November 15, 1993. She was also predeceased by her parents, two brothers and four sisters.

She is survived by her sons, Dr. Paul (Ruth) Palma and Dr. Timothy (Joy) Palma, eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

The family is deeply indebted to Unit 2 of the Syracuse Home for their compassionate care, where Esther resided for her final years.

Funeral services will be held 9:30 AM Monday at Grace Assembly of God Church, 4220 Fay Rd., Syracuse, to be followed by interment at the White Chapel Memory Gardens in Dewitt.
