



EUGENE "GINO" SCARSCIOTTI

October 23, 1962 - January 26, 2019

Eugene "Gino" Scarsciotti, 56, of E. Syracuse, passed away at home Saturday surrounded by his family and friends. He was born in Syracuse and worked for the NYSDOT out of Camillus for many years before retiring and was past president of CSEA Local 528.

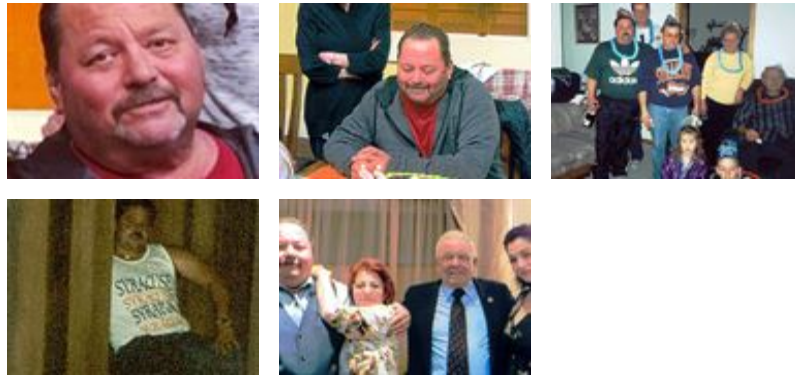
