*Forget Me Not*

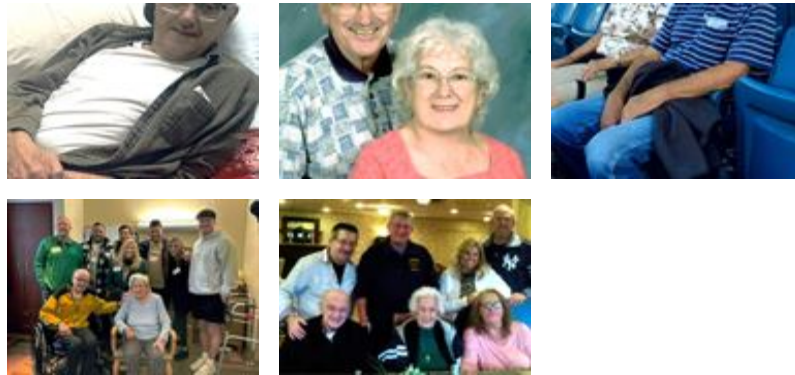
*Don't remember me not with sadness,

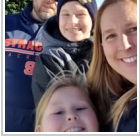
