Ines M. (Venturini) Savo, 84, of Solvay, passed away Friday, September 30th at Crouse Hospital surrounded by her family. She was born in Solvay to the late Guido and Oliva Venturini in 1932 and graduate of Solvay High School Class of 1950. Ines worked as an assembler at GE for several years. She later worked at St. Cecilia's School as a custodian before retiring in 1994 from the rectory where she was a housekeeper and office assistant.
