



JACK E. JONES

March 31, 1950 - December 12, 2022

Jack E. Jones, 72, of Solvay, passed away at home on Monday, December 12 after a long battle with several cancers. He was born in Binghamton to the late Jack and Mary (Olbrys) Jones and was employed as a tractor trailer driver for the U.S. Postal Service. Jack served in the U.S. Army in Vietnam from 1967 - 1970, and received the bronze star. Jack became disabled in 1986 after changing a tire on route 81, and was struck by an oncoming vehicle. Jack enjoyed spending time with his family, camping at Cross Lake, hunting, playing pool, listening to the Oldies, tending the POW/MIA table, and playing practical jokes on April Fool's Day. He was predeceased by his parents Jack and Mary (Olbrys) Jones, his baby daughter, Laura Jones, and his sister, Caroline Humphrey.

He is survived by his loving wife and caretaker of 52 years, Luana (Shoff) Jones; his siblings; Tom, Sandy, Diana, and Bonnie; his children; Jack Jr., Loana, and Laura; grandchildren; Anna, Brittany, Brandon, Ciara and Natalia, and his great-grandson Soren, as well as many nieces, nephews, and cousins.
