



## JACQUELINE (ARTINI) TODESCHINI

August 28, 1923 - March 31, 2017

Jacqueline (Artini) Todeschini, 93, of Solvay, went to be with the Lord on Friday March 31, 2017 at St. Joseph's Hospital surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Zuclo, Italy to the late Vigilio and Annunziata (Rivani) Artini, and immigrated to America in 1937. During World War II, she worked at the Camillus Cutlery making bayonets for the war effort. She was a longtime communicant of St. Cecilia Church and a member of both the St. Anthony Society and Altar and Rosary Society. She served on the Ladies Auxiliaries of the Tyrol Club and Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post 2893. She was predeceased by her husband of 46 years, Leo in 1992 and her grandson, Craig Todeschini in 2006.
