James V. "Tippy" Abbatiello, 92, of Rochester, formerly of Syracuse, passed away Saturday at Highland Hospital in Rochester. He was a proud US Army Veteran of World War II serving in the Battle of the Bulge and was awarded both the Purple Heart and Bronze Star during his service.
