John Barreca, 87, of Solvay, passed away Tuesday at home after succumbing to C.O.P.D. Born and raised in Solvay, John graduated from Solvay High School in 1953, attended Le Moyne College and served in the Air National Guard. John would later join his brothers in business as owner-operator of the Green Front Market. Many will remember John serving his community by bringing grocery orders to families and their homes as a communicant of St. Cecilia's Church. John retired in 1992. In retirement John continued to enjoy his family and friends, often found playing cards or stopping in to drop off treats.
