John was very active within the local, county and state volunteer fire service. He was an active member of the Fairmount Fire Department for over 30 years and served as Chief from 1981-1984. John also served as President of Western Section Line Officers Assoc., President Onondaga County Volunteer Firemen Assoc., President Onondaga County Fire Chiefs Assoc. and was very active within the State Volunteer Fire Association (FASNY) where he held several posts. In addition to his dedication to the fire service has he was also a member of Town of Camillus Planning Board. John was an active member of the committee in establishing the Burn Treatment Center at Upstate Medical Center in 1979. 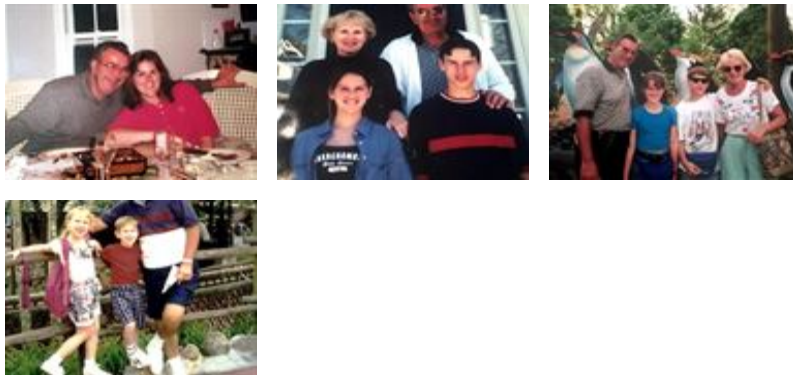

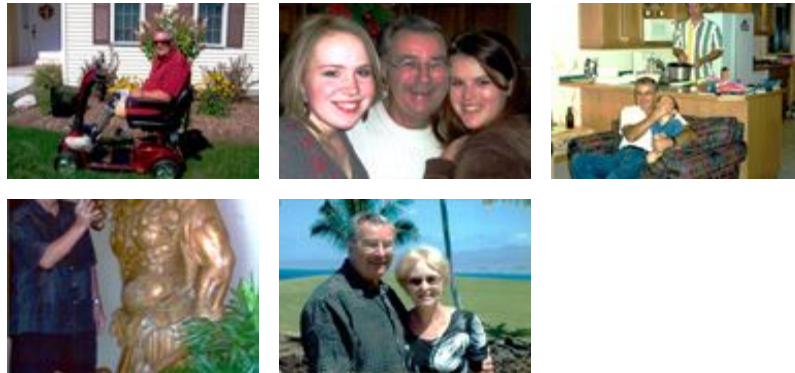
