John J. Sciuga, 86, of Syracuse, passed away Thursday at St. Camillus. He was born in Syracuse to the late Frank and Katherine (Cilani) Sciuga in 1933 and lived in Syracuse all his life. He wintered in Clearwater, FL for many years. He retired after 25 years of service as a Teamster Local 317. In his later years, he worked at Lorenzo's Wholesale Food Co. John graduated from Vocational High School where he played football for 3 years and also played 5 years of semi-pro football in CNY.
