



JOSEPH L. POLI

September 1, 1937 - January 25, 2019

Joseph L. Poli, 81, of Geddes, passed away Friday at St. Joseph's Hospital surrounded by his family. He was born in Syracuse to the late Lino and Anna (Matrone) Poli in 1937. He graduated from Vocational High School and served with the US Army from 1956-1959. Joe was a Police Officer with the Solvay Police Department for 13 years after which he transferred to the Geddes Police Department for 18 years before retiring as sergeant on the midnight shift. Joe was an avid bowler, hunter and Yankee fan. He was a communicant of St. Cecilia Church, loved to travel and was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police. Joe was predeceased by his wife of 44 years, Mary Jane (Panighetti) in 2011 and son, William in 2013.

He is survived by his children; Steven (Rebecca Hilts) Poli, of N. Syracuse, Karen Valentine, of Minoa, and Joseph (Tara) Poli, of Solvay, 9 grandchildren; Samantha and Sydney Valentine, Duke Pugh, Jon, Kim, Lino and Andrea Poli, Alexis Calhoun and Brenna Poli, 1 great-granddaughter; Ayla Calhoun, his brother; Daniel Poli, of N. Syracuse and many nieces and nephews.

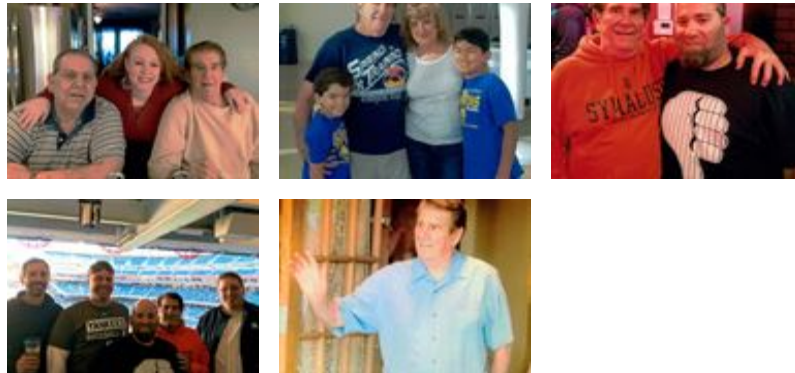
