Joseph Vincent Scrivani, M.D., of Fayetteville, New York died on November 16, 2019 at Elderwood after a brief illness. He was born July 27, 1933 in Niagara Falls, New York, the son of Vincent Scrivani and Mary (Sardella) Scrivani. Upon graduating SUNY Upstate Medical University in 1960, he served two years in the U.S. Air Force. He completed a residency in radiology at the University of Oregon in 1966 and retired from SUNY Upstate Hospital in 2006, where he was Director of Women's Imaging.
