Louis R. Frio, formerly of Syracuse, NY, died at home on Sunday, August 13, surrounded by his loving family. Lou, the son of Salvatore and Antoinette (DePaul) Frio, received his BS degree from Lemoyne College and a MS degree in education from Syracuse University. He taught at Bear Road Elementary and Gillette Road Middle Schools in the North Syracuse Central School District for 32 years. He retired in December 1992. He entered the Military Service in Oct 1956 to 1958 with the U.S Army Band. Upon discharge, he married his wife Ann, in November. Lou cherished time with his family, and also enjoyed sports, music, and crossword puzzles.

Surviving Lou are his wife of 58 years, Ann (Falso), daughter, Luanne (Mike) Hills, son, Lou (Peggy Burke), grandchildren, Sara (Mitchell) Soper, Chris Hills, Melissa, Jessie, and Michael Frio, and great granddaughter Isabelle Marie Soper.
