



LOUIS NICOLINI

September 1, 1930 - July 28, 2024

Louis Nicolini, 93, of Solvay, passed away peacefully at Francis House July 28th. He was born September 1, 1930 to the late Bernard and Marsilia (Ghezzi) Nicolini. Louie was a Solvay High school graduate and a Korean War Veteran. After the war, Louie was employed by Solvay Process until its closing in 1986 as a Crane Operator.

He volunteered as a bingo announcer at the Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post 2893 on Wednesday nights. He was an Usher at St. Cecilia Church for more than 40 years. He belonged to the Tyrol Club of Solvay and created the famous Salamini recipe that was enjoyed by many in the Solvay community. Through the years Louie enjoyed making wine, sausage and gardening and could be seen taking morning walks with his dogs.

Louis is predeceased by his wife of 66 years, Mary (Maestri) Nicolini in 2022, his brothers, Columbo and Alfred.

He is survived by his daughter, Anne (Rich) Morgan, of Camillus; son, James Nicolini, of Solvay; granddaughters, Leighanne (Jon) Hibbard, of Chittenango, Elizabeth Morgan, of Camillus and grandson, Tyler Nicolini, of Fulton and several nieces and nephews.

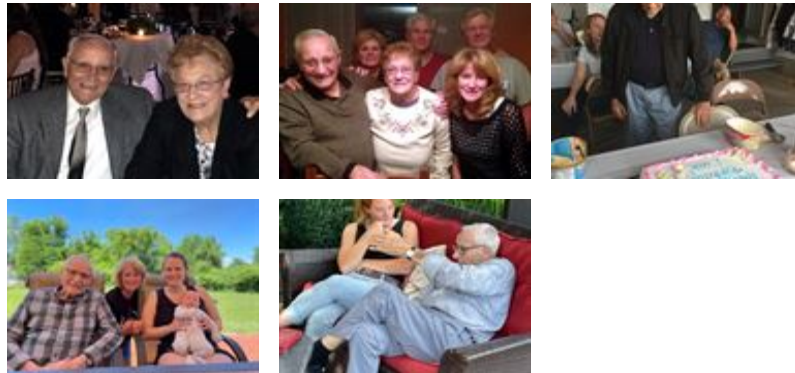
