

LOUIS D. ZINGARO, JR.

July 12, 1930 - August 26, 2020

Louis Dominick Zingaro Jr., age 90, of Lakeland, passed peacefully on August 26th, 2020 at Crouse Hospital surrounded by his loving wife and children.

Louie was born on July 12th, 1930 in Solvay to the late Theresa (Spicciati) Zingaro and Luigi Zingaro. He was the youngest of nine children.

Louie was a 1948 graduate of Solvay High School and a 1949 graduate of Central City Business Institute (CCBI). He was a United States Marine Corps veteran during the Korean War, stationed at Camp Pendleton, California.

Louie was a Property Records Accountant for Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation for 39 years before retiring in December 1991. During his tenure, he earned several Exceptional Service Awards from the company.

He was a member of the Solvay-Geddes Veterans Association, a proud union member of IBEW Local 1484 and a communicant of Our Lady of Peace Church in Lakeland.

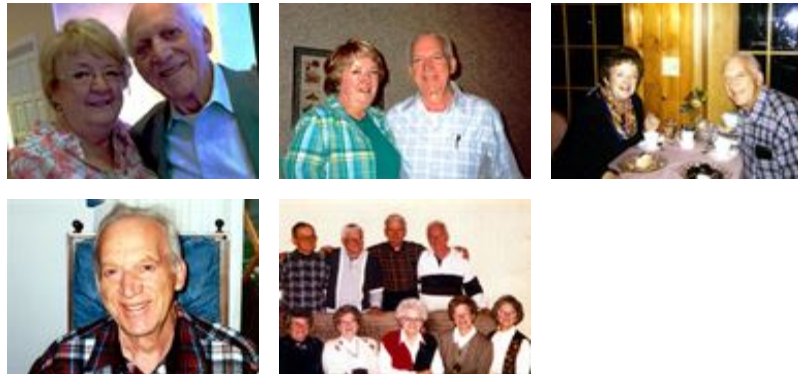
