



## LYDIA (DESANTIS) DUCETT

June 1, 1926 - October 10, 2022

Lydia Ducett, 96, of Solvay, passed away Monday, October 10, 2022 at Upstate University Hospital, Syracuse. She was born in Syracuse to the late Nicholas and Josephine (Jerome) DeSantis in 1926.
