



MARGARET (BALDUZZI) SAUDA

December 15, 1919 - February 16, 2018

Margaret (Balduzzi) Sauda, age 98, of Solvay, died peacefully on Friday, February 16th at St Camillus Health and Rehabilitation Center. Margaret was born in Solvay on December 15, 1919, the daughter of Placido and Erminia Balduzzi. A graduate of Solvay High School and Central City Business Institute, she worked for several companies as an administrative assistant and later as the bookkeeper for her husband's business, Sauda's Cleaners. A lifelong communicant of St. Cecilia's Catholic Church, Margaret was an active member of the Altar & Rosary Society and a volunteer with St. Cecilia's Food Pantry for over 25 years. She was a longtime member of the Solvay Tyrol Club Auxiliary as well as the Solvay Seniors. She was predeceased by her husband Edwin in 1981.

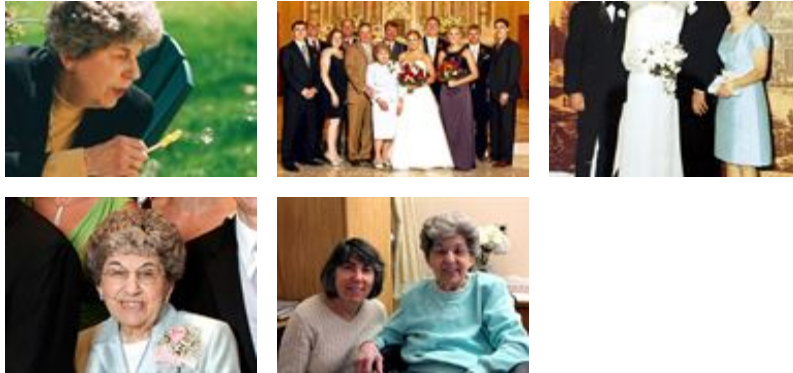
