Marie A. (Massimiano) Impaglia, age 93, passed away peacefully at home in the care of her loving family on July 9, 2021. Marie was born in Auburn, New York to the late Rocco and Elisa (Bartoli) Massimiano. It was on Cottage Street in Auburn, as a child, that she met her future husband, Michael. Marie graduated from East High School. She studied art at Syracuse University and finally completed her art degree at Onondaga Community College at the age of 64. She married her sweetheart, Dr. Michael A. Impaglia, on August 13, 1952 and followed him as he served in the United States Air Force Dental Corps in France. Less than 3 years later they returned to Auburn, with two babies and a French poodle. They then began to plan their future. After growing their family by two more children, Marie became the office manager and assistant in Michael's dental practice for over 50 years in Fairmount. Marie was predeceased by her husband of 68 years in June, 2020. She is also predeceased by grandson, Christopher Impaglia, great grandson, Joshua Impaglia and brother, Alphonse.

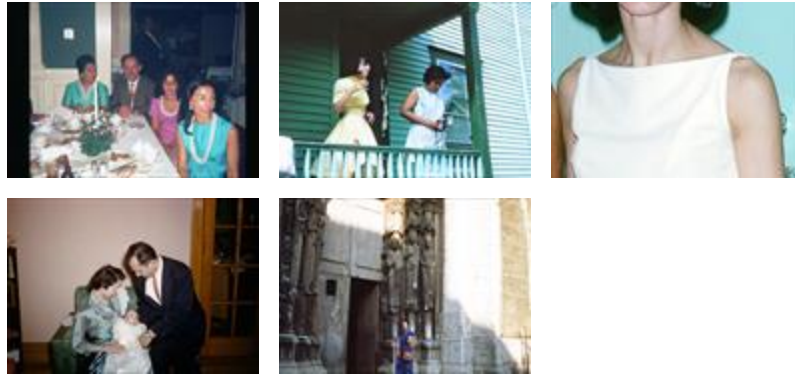
