



MARIO B. TOMASETTI

November 19, 1932 - January 24, 2023

Mario B. Tomasetti, 90, of Solvay, passed away peacefully on January 24th at Crouse Hospital. He was born to the late Pietro and Dorothea (Cristoforetti) Tomasetti in 1932. He was a lifelong resident of Solvay where he married Rosemary (Kincler) in 1956. They were partners in life for 66 years. Mario spent over 30 years in the Syracuse School System running the Johnson Vocational Center. He was most proud of being able to work with local businesses and write grants to fund programs for students and adults at the Center. One of his greatest loves was Solvay – He spent his years working to make the Village a better place. “Down Solvay’s Memory Lane” was his creation and became a staple in the electric bills for years. He is the Village Historian by all accounts. He was a member of the Solvay Tyrol Club, Rotary and spearheaded the Solvay Centennial celebration in 1994. In recent years his greatest joy was spending time with his children and grandchildren. He is predeceased by his sister, Rose (Salvagno) and his brother, Albert who gave his life serving our country in WWII.

He is survived by his wife, Rosemary, daughter, Susan Tremont, of Liverpool, son, Daniel (Adele), of Elmsford, NY and 4 grandchildren, Liane (Ray) Byrne, Staci (David) Burns, Austin Tomasetti and Abigail Tremont.
