



## Mary (Mozo) Armani

December 25, 1927 - February 12, 2017

Mary N. Armani, 89, of Camillus, passed away Sunday, February 12th at St. Joseph's Hospital in Syracuse. She was born Natalia M. Mozo, December 25, 1927, to the late Feliciano and Maria (Porto) Mozo. Mary was a life-long resident of the Camillus/ Fairmount area. She graduated from Solvay High School '46 with honors, attended Syracuse University where she worked as secretary for the Athletic Department. In her long work life, she was a secretary at General Electric, a real estate agent, owner and manager of commercial real estate, and for many years, owned and operated Little Europe Ski Shop in Fairmount.

She and her family traveled extensively throughout Europe, and later in life, Mary and Frank traveled the world. Mary was a gifted singer and homemaker and devoted wife, mother, aunt and friend . She was predeceased by her brothers, Casper Mozo, Emelio Mozo and Santos Mozo.

Survived by her husband of 66 years, Frank H. Armani, a retired Syracuse attorney, her two daughters, Debra and Dorina, her brother, Felix (Peggy) Mozo, of Florida, sisters-in-law, Margery Mozo, of Kirkville, Arlene Mozo, Syracuse and Doris Chester, of Georgia, nieces and nephews.
