Mary C. Bondoni, 84, of Solvay, passed away Sunday at Loretto. She was born in Trento, Italy to the late Victor and Perina (Belli) Bondoni in 1933, immigrating to the US in 1934. Mary was a bookkeeper at Will and Baumer Candle Co. for over 50 years before retiring in 2008.
