



MATTHEW "MATT" L. CACOSSA

June 9, 1964 - May 11, 2022

Matthew L. Cacossa, 57, of Solvay, passed away unexpectedly from complications of COVID and other prior health issues on May 11, 2022. Matt was a 1982 graduate of Solvay High School, and was listed in the book of "Who's Who Among American High School Students". He started working at Solvay Public Library while he was in high school, and worked there for over 20 years. Also while in high school he worked at Cavages Records as a sales clerk, and advanced to manager of the ShoppingTown Mall location in Dewitt. He continued working at those two jobs while attending Le Moyne College, where he graduated with two degrees, Psychology and Business Administration, in 1986. Upon graduation he worked for Bryant & Stratton, assisting high school students with college applications, grants, and financial aid. He worked for a short time with Comtech, and then Fay's Drug Corporation Central Office, in the bookkeeping department. Thereafter he was hired by Niagara Mohawk (later National Grid) in 1989, working for over 30 years, beginning in the mailroom, moving into accounts payable, multiple temp jobs, customer service and then service dispatch department, where he retired from in 2020. Introduced to music at an early age by his sister, he was not just a collector of records but a voracious consumer of all styles of music (although anyone who knew him knows his favorite band was the Beatles). He attended countless concerts, locally and out of town, all with friends and family, and all were memorable to him. Matthew was devoted to his family. He spent hours with his nephews, John and Paul, sharing his love of music with

them, since they were very young. He would take them to various records stores and later many concerts. He spread that love of music to his great nephews and niece. Matt was predeceased by his mother, Marie Estelle (Veri) Cacossa.

He is survived by his sister, Audrey (Jack) Kelly, of Solvay, nephews, John (Jennifer) Kelly, of South Carolina, and Paul Kelly, of Solvay, great nephews, Collin, Brandon, and Evan, great niece Nora, many cousins, and too many friends to count.

“ I have so many fond memories of Matt that it is hard to know where to start. Although my husband Tim never knew Matt in person, he came to know him through my stories of him as well as his album anniversary postings. It was Tim’s suggestion that I honor Matt in this manner:

ALBUM ANNIVERSARY: Released 20,795 days ago today. Matt Cacossa, the second child of Marie Estelle was released on June 9, 1965.

In the early years, Matt could be found with his jovial attitude and his crisp witticisms in the Dolphy lounge at LeMoyne College in Syracuse, NY. It was here that he garnered the attention of Dianne Hulsmann. It would be a couple of years before this encounter came to fruition. In 1985, Matt caught the eye of Robert Robbins of Cavages Records and Tapes at Shoppingtown Mall. It wasn’t long after this connection was made that Matt collaborated with Dianne on many trips to Jack Wolack’s Rare Necessities, Desert Shore Records, and Olivers. Matt’s demanding tour schedule took him on countless trips to the “House of Guitars” in Rochester, NY, where Matt was happy to relieve them of as much vinyl as humanly possible. Not to be outdone, Matt attended every record convention from Utica to Syracuse and Rochester. As Matt’s popularity continued to grow, he would grace his fans with some tidbit of knowledge or piece of trivia about their favorite bands. During his climb to the top, Matt brought down the house on Sgt. Pepper’s Day at Cavages, and he demonstrated his multi talents with his I-81 Halloween costume. Although he sometimes mistook Dianne for Rand McNally, they could often be found sharing a gourmet meal together in the wilds of Chittenango while listening to David effing Essex. Although Matt almost certainly lost some hearing at that Cheap Trick concert in Utica, NY, he was certain that Bob Dylan did not utter one single intelligible word at the concert at the NYS fairgrounds. Matt helped Dianne to find many of her vinyl treasures including “Rock and Rule” which featured both Debbie Harry and Cheap Trick. There were many hours of musing over “That Will Be the Day,” and “Stardust”. It is uncertain if Matt is enjoying a “cofa-

cuppy” or a “marnagrita”, but he is most certainly contemplating some “Blue Suede Ludes.” Although Matt is no longer gracing our stage, there is no question that he is giving Rock and Roll Heaven one hell of a show.
