



NIKODEM MICHALKOW

September 13, 1940 - March 15, 2021

Nikodem Michalkow, 80, of Warners, passed away March 15th at home surrounded by his family. He was born in Wabrenzno, Poland to the late Jan and Helena (Dobies) Michalkow on September 13th 1940. He served in the Polish Navy. After immigrating to the U.S., he began his career working as a plant maintenance manager for Loblaws, followed by maintenance for Schlitz Brewery, a crane repairman and millwright for Crucible Steel and in brewing maintenance for Anheuser-Busch in Baldwinsville, where he retired in 2009 after 25 years. He was a longtime communicant of the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He was predeceased by his loving wife, Janina "Jasia" (Pogorzelski) in 2010, his brother, Jan Michalkow and sister, Krystyna Kutta. He is survived by his 3 sons; Christian (Renee'), of Warners, Johnny (Dawn), of Lakeland and Nicholas, of Charlotte, NC, 5 grandchildren; Anastasia, Nikolette, Tyler, Austin, and Alex, brother; Fabian (Maria), of Brewerton, 2 sisters; Barbara Rataj and Ula Tryczak, both of Poland and many nieces and nephews.
