

## Norman E. Nicolini

October 2, 1926 - August 27, 2017

Norman E. Nicolini, 90, of Solvay, passed away Sunday surrounded by his family at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Solvay to the late Candido and Bona (Capella) Nicolini in 1926. Norm was a US Army Veteran of World War II participating in the occupation of Japan. He worked as a type setter, photo engraver, television repairman and Supervisor for the Village of Solvay Highway Department. He was a member of 3 unions, the Type Setters, Printers and GCC/IBT Local 503-M. Other memberships included the Tyrol Club of Solvay, Stanley B. Pennock VFW Post 2893, Geddes Veterans Association and was a life member of the DAV. He enjoyed watching his grandchildren participate in their many activities. He also enjoyed cooking polenta for his family and loved watching birds, gardening and woodworking. He was a die-hard Yankee fan, loved watching SU sports, playing softball for the Solvay Tyrol Club Softball Team and was an avid bowler-who proudly wore his American Bowling Congress 800 Ring. He enjoyed being a "snowbird" for 18 years, spending 6 months in Apollo Beach, FL and 6 months in Solvay.

He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Jacqueline (Giromini) and sister, Hilda Todeschini.

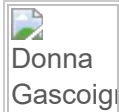
