Patrick Simiele, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed away peacefully at Francis House, on October 20, 2017, at the age of 80, with Rosemary, his wife of 58 years, and his family by his side.

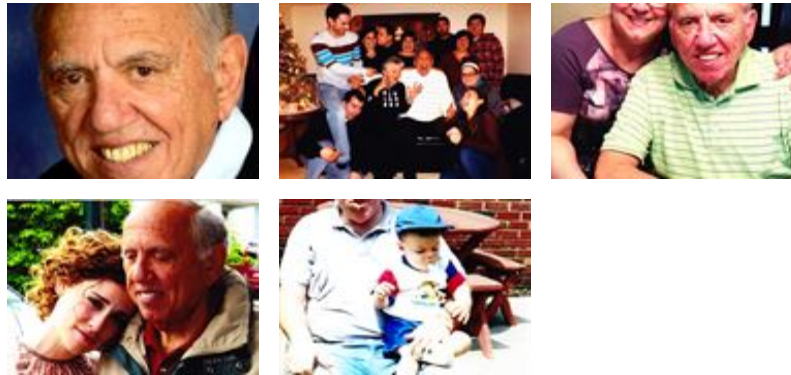
