



RENO "POP" PAUSSA

September 28, 1923 - March 28, 2017

Reno R. "Pop" Paussa, 93, of Solvay, passed away Tuesday March 28, 2017 at Upstate University Hospital. He was born in Solvay to the late John and Olga (Bodigoi) Paussa in 1923. Reno was a US Navy Veteran serving on the USS LST 377 during World War II. He was a longtime mechanic and service manager, retiring from Bill Scott Oldsmobile. He was a past member of the Geddes Veteran's Association and was an avid bowler in both the Tuesday night league at Fairmount and Thursday night at Thunderbird Lanes. Reno was a communicant of St. Cecilia Church. He was predeceased by his wife of 54 years, Norma (Maestri) Paussa, 2 sisters, Bruna Salvagno and Inez Armani, brother, Bruno Paussa and sister-in-law, Judy Bombard.
