Ronald M. Balduzzi, 74, passed away on January 31, 2021, after fighting a long and courageous battle against colon cancer. Ronald was born in Syracuse, New York, on December 14, 1946, to the late Guido J. “Baldy” Balduzzi and the late Florence (Pisarek) Balduzzi. Ronald was a life resident of Syracuse, New York and graduated from West Genesee High School in 1964. “Ron” served in the Army Reserve and earned an Associates Degree from Powelson Business Institute and later a Bachelor's Degree from Columbia College. Ronald married his wife of 49 years, Kathryn “Taffy” (Dineen) on October 30, 1971. Ron and Taffy had three daughters who they raised in Camillus, New York. 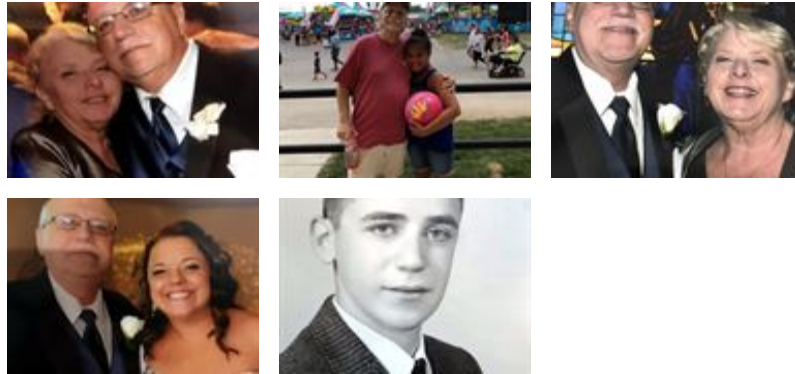
