Ronald A. Cerutti, 68, of Camillus, passed away peacefully Saturday at home. He was born in Syracuse to the late Gaudenzio and Ventina (Ventre) Cerutti in 1949. Ron graduated from Bishop Ludden High School in 1969 and Onondaga Community College in 1971. He was a US Air Force Veteran, serving active and reserve duty from 1969 - 1990. He was employed by Verizon as a switchman for 36 years before retiring in 2005. Ron was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church, a member of the 174th Alumni and West Genesee High School Marching Band's "Pit Crew". He also volunteered for the DAV as a transporter and was an avid golfer.
